JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE OF POSITION

BUS DRIVER

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be at least twenty-one (21) years old.
2. Must possess a valid Washington State Drivers License.
3. Must obtain a Commercial Drivers License Class B, with endorsements P1 and S.
4. Must meet and continue to meet all standards and regulations established by OSPI and the State of Washington.
5. Must pass physical exam to meet health requirements for DOT/CDL:
 - a. Vision in both eyes as well as each eye individually needs to be 20/40, with visual improvement devices, such as glasses or contacts permitted
 - b. Ability to distinguish color is necessary
 - c. Needs to be able to perceive a forced whisper at a distance of at least 5 feet
 - d. Maximum allowable blood pressure is 160/100. Use of prescription medication to achieve this threshold is allowed
 - e. Persons with diabetes that requires insulin injections have additional clearance requirements; diabetes controlled through a diet or oral medication is permitted
 - f. Blood sugar may not be higher than 200. No use of a Schedule 1 drug, amphetamine, narcotic or any habit forming drug is allowed
6. Fingerprinting and background check required.
7. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

JOB GOALS:

Safely transport students to and from school and on field trips or extra-curricular trips.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Drive buses on regularly scheduled routes or on field trips or activity trips.
2. Maintain control over passengers as related to safety.
3. Participate in bus driver training courses as required to meet standards.
4. May be required to keep bus clean and fueled.
5. Perform such other related duties as may be directed by supervisor.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Salary and work year to be established by the Board.

EVALUATION:

Performance of this position will be evaluated annually in accordance with the provisions of the Board's policy on evaluation of classified personnel.
